- Refrain from using or possessing tobacco, alcohol, or illegal or performance-enhancing drugs.

- Failure to abide by the aforementioned rules and guidelines may result in disciplinary action by United Philly Soccer Club that could include, but is not limited to, the following:
 - Warning
 - Probation (monitoring by the HOC)
 - Game suspension
 - Season suspension
